Effectiveness of the Eleventh Replenishment of the Asian Development Fund and Sixth Regularized Replenishment of the Technical Assistance Special Fund

- 1. On 30 May 2017, instruments of contribution deposited with the Asian Development Bank for unqualified contributions to the Eleventh Replenishment of the Asian Development Fund and Sixth Regularized Replenishment of the Technical Assistance Special Fund (ADF 12 and TASF 6) reached \$1,824,518,117 equivalent. This amount is more than 50% of all donor contributions reflected in Tables A and B of Resolution No. 382 of the Board of Governors. It includes the contributions of Ireland; Kazakhstan; and the Netherlands, which were not reflected in Table A of the resolution, and the increased contributions of Finland. Consequently, ADF 12 and TASF 6 became effective on 30 May 2017 in accordance with para. 5(a) of the resolution.
- 2. Table 1 presents the status of ADF 12 and TASF 6 contributions as of 30 May 2017.
