### I. CONSISTENCY OF BUSINESS PLAN WITH COUNTRY PARTNERSHIP STRATEGY

1. The country operations business plan (COBP), 2018–2020 for the People's Republic of China (PRC) is consistent with the strategic priorities of the Asian Development Bank (ADB) country partnership strategy (CPS), 2016–2020 for the PRC, the priorities of the government's 13th Five-Year Plan, 2016–2020, and ADB's strategic priorities as outlined in the Midterm Review of Strategy 2020. <sup>1</sup> It was prepared based on agreements reached during the country programming mission in Yueyang, Hunan Province, in October 2017.

2. The COBP builds on past efforts to incorporate innovative elements, add value, leverage finance and knowledge, and contribute to capacity development of human resources in the PRC. It focuses on innovation and high-impact technology; fostering of regional and global public goods such as pollution control and climate change mitigation and adaptation; promotion of equal access to services and environmentally sustainable development; reduction of rural–urban disparities and promotion of international cooperation and regional connectivity, trade, and investments (Appendix 1 and 2). The COBP also reinforces the vision to deepen the partnership between the PRC and ADB in the area of knowledge and to share knowledge solutions created through ADB operations in the PRC with other developing member countries for enhanced development impact in the PRC and Asia and the Pacific.

## II. INDICATIVE RESOURCE PARAMETERS

3. The PRC, a group C developing member country, is eligible for regular ordinary capital resources (OCR) lending. The indicative resources available for commitments during 2018–2020 for sovereign operations amount to \$5.25 billion. The COBP 2018–2020 consists of 32 firm lending projects totaling \$6.15 billion and eight standby lending projects for 2020 totaling \$1.66 billion, both on a transitional approval basis reflecting an understanding reached at the country programming mission in October 2017 (Appendix 3, Table A3.1). These totals will be adjusted as the program transitions to commitments in 2018. Cofinancing and funding from other sources, including the regular OCR regional cooperation and integration set-aside, will also be explored.

4. Nonsovereign operations will continue to support environmental protection, climate change adaptation, inclusive growth, and regional cooperation with a focus on new business models and new technological solutions. Financing will be direct and through intermediaries and will target environmental solutions such as sustainable energy delivery, waste management and clean water, food safety and agricultural development, as well as social sector investments to meet basic human needs. Investments in the finance sector will focus on promoting the development of small and medium-sized enterprises, as well as leasing and supply-chain finance. Non-sovereign operations will also seek to expand support for reform-minded state-owned enterprises and greater synergies with sovereign operations.

5. The nonlending program for 2018–2020 (Appendix 3, Table A3.2) will enhance the design, preparation and readiness of the lending program and support knowledge creation, management and sharing, both within the PRC and with other developing economies. The TA program has a strong thematic focus, in line with the lending program and in response to the government's priorities. The 2018 nonlending program consists of 29 TA projects with a total value of \$14.3 million financed from ADB's Technical Assistance Special Fund. Ten TA projects (total value: \$7 million) are categorized as transaction TA, and 19 TA projects (total value: \$7.3 million) as

knowledge and support TA. ADB will seek to mobilize additional resources from other TA funds and facilities available to ADB, as well as TA cofinancing from other development partners.

6. The indicative 2018–2020 lending and nonlending pipelines are organized around the following four core themes that address the complex development issues of the PRC in a strategic way with high-value multisector programs:

- a) **Environment and climate change.** This encompasses the two flagship programs, Beijing– Tianjin–Hebei air pollution control and Yangtze River Economic Belt, as well as sustainable urbanization, and other environment-related programs.
- b) *Inclusive development*. This covers rural transformation, North-East revitalization, demographic transition (aging and education), and other social inclusion programs.
- c) **Regional cooperation and integration.** This covers regional cooperation initiatives to support the participation of PRC provinces in ADB's subregional programs (Central Asia Regional Economic Cooperation and Greater Mekong Subregion), the Belt and Road Initiative, and other regional integration activities by promoting regional connectivity, trade and investment, and regional public goods.
- d) **Institution building.** This covers public sector management (e.g., public–private partnerships, central–local fiscal relations, eco-compensation), the finance sector (e.g., green finance and bond market), and other institution-building activities (e.g., legal and judicial reform).

7. The sector-specific allocation of resources in the 2018–2020 lending pipeline covers transport (24%); water and other urban infrastructure and services (24%); agriculture, natural resources, and rural development (22%); and energy (15%). Support to elderly care will account for 7%, support to industry and trade for 6%, and support to education for 2%.

8. Appendix 4 shows the indicative list of knowledge publications and events for 2018, as well as additional knowledge publications and events delivered in 2017 and innovation, advanced technology, and pilot initiatives to be implemented in 2018.

### III. SUMMARY OF CHANGES TO LENDING AND NONLENDING PROGRAMS

9. Changes to the lending pipeline from the COBP, 2017–2019 were mainly the result of placing greater emphasis on multisector interventions for environment-related programs (such as YREB development and sustainable urbanization) and inclusive development (such as education and elderly care) with 10 new firm projects.<sup>2</sup> Changes to the nonlending pipeline result from 17 new knowledge and support TA projects, and from carrying over two such TA projects from the 2017 program to 2018.
